# Strohm Photography-Preparing your house for listing photos

## First impressions begin with photos!

The house must be ready for the day of the listing photos. Here are some guidelines to get your house looking its best for photos and for showings.

#### Inside-

- De-clutter as much as possible. Put away toys, clothing, dishes, towels, shoes, phone chargers, etc.
- Depersonalized to a certain degree. Minimize family photos and other personalized items
- Make any repairs and touchups
- When possible remove any seasonal/holiday decorations that can quickly outdate your photos.
- · Dust, vacuum, mop and clean windows
- · Make all the beds, fluff all the pillows, and check the bed skirts.



- · Clean the kitchen and put away all the dishes.
- · Remove all magnets and decorations from the refrigerator.
- Clear all kitchen counter tops and put away toasters, can openers, etc. Have buyers look at your space and not your stuff.

- Clear all bathroom counter tops, put away all personal items
- Remove all shampoos, conditioners, body-washes, etc. from the shower.
- Put out fresh towels.
- · Put all toilet seats and lids down.
- If there are pets, hide all food/water bowls, pet beds, and pet toys.
- Replace all burned out light bulbs.



#### Outside

- Have the lawn trimmed, leaves raked, bushes and trees pruned
- Put away all garbage cans, hoses, garden tools, toys, bikes etc.
- In snowy climates, shovel snow from walkways, driveways, patios, decks when necessary.
- If there is a pool, hot tub, or spa, take any security gate down, uncover, and clean.
- · Open the umbrellas on any patio sets.
- Uncover grills.
- · Remove any seasonal/holiday decorations.
- Consider adding splashes of bright colored flowers to the landscape and in pots.

### Day of photos

- Turn on ALL interior lights even lights in furniture cabinets.
- Turn OFF all ceiling fans.
- · Light fireplaces and candles.
- Open all blinds, shades, and curtains.
- · Clear all cars, vehicles and trash from the driveway
- Please secure any animals in a safe location, away from all rooms being photographed.
